**10:02** Introductory remarks from Richard Clarke. Co-chairs emphasized the need for the Work Groups to rapidly complete input for the first annual report. Desire to see detailed recommendations for policy, legislation, and budgetary input that Governor and staff can immediately take for action. Each recommendation should have associated metrics that can demonstrate desired impact.

**10:12** Minutes from the 18 March 2015 4th Commission Meeting were reviewed by members; a motion to approve the minutes was made and seconded. All members voted to approve the minutes as written.

**10:13** Marion Cain from the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Training Readiness and Strategy, provided a briefing on the DoD Skillbridge Program for transitioning veterans. The briefing generated numerous questions from the Commissioners. Key takeaways from the briefing included the potential for Commonwealth of Virginia to potentially act as a “bridge” to generate industry and DoD (especially VA based DoD facilities) relationships to ensure Virginia industries have full visibility of and first access to these transitioning personnel. Co-chairs tasked the Education and Workforce Development Work Group to further evaluate the Skillbridge program and develop recommendations on how to create the desired “bridging” capability.

**10:20** Paul Kurtz briefed Commission members on the Infrastructure Work Group activities and plans. The initial results of the Commonwealth Agency security programs survey were briefed; further analysis is needed to generate the final recommendations. An overview of the Work Group input for the annual report was provided.

**10:32** Barry Horowitz briefed Economic Development Work Group activities and plans. An overview of the input to the first annual report was provided and included the strategies for developing new markets in cyber security capabilities of automobiles and UAV’s, new certificate programs for cyber security specialists in this field, and grant funding to support programs of this nature..

**10:47** Bob Day briefed the Commission on the continued success of the Town Hall

program and likelihood that additional events will be conducted. Paul Kurtz suggested that the Work Group consider developing a web based feedback and survey application to further capture attendee ideas and input after the event.

- 10:52** Andrew Turner briefed the Commission on the Education Work Group activities. There was significant discussion on how to create a virtual cyber lab environment to assist Virginia community colleges more easily attain CAE 2Y accreditation and rapidly produce certified cyber professionals and forensics specialists.
- 11:03** Paul Tiao provided an overview of the final report from the George Washington University (GWU) team analysis of Commonwealth statute and law with respect to Cyber Security issues.
- 11:18** The floor was opened for Public Comment. None presented.
- 11:24** Co-Chair Richard Clarke moved that the meeting be adjourned, the motion was seconded. Meeting adjourned.
- 11:30** Governor McAuliffe, Bill Patrons, and Commission Members participated in a signing ceremony for SB1307, SB919, SB1121, and HB1562. These bills were generated as a result of the Cyber Crime Work Group efforts along with significant work by the McAuliffe administration.
